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1 III. SPECIFIC ACTIVITIES IN ROADLESS AREAS

2 Plaintiffs have asked the Court to issue a specific injunction for a group of oil and gas leases
3 and a specific road building project. The Court addresses each in turn.

4 A. Oil and Gas Leases

5 The Court orders that the 2001 Roadless Rule shall apply to any mineral leases of National
6 Forest lands issued after January 12, 2001, and, accordingly, the Forest Service is enjoined from
7 approving or allowing any surface use of a mineral lease issued after January 12, 2001, that would
8 violate the Roadless Rule (including the Tongass amendment). This order does not apply to roads
9 that have already been constructed or reconstructed on lease parcels pursuant to approved surface
10 use plans of operation.

11 B. Coal Creek-Big Creek Road Project, Salmon-Challis NF, Idaho

12 The Court orders that the Forest Service is enjoined from proceeding with the Coal Creek-
13 Big Creek Road Project.

15 This order supersedes that portion of this Court's order of September 20, 2006 (amended
16 October 11, 2006) that grants injunctive relief.
